Commitment to the Christian Community for support and leadership:

Do you promise to look to the church for spiritual guidance, to walk in a spirit of Christian love with this congregation, and to seek those things that make for unity, purity and peace?

By God's grace, I do.

Commitment to the historic Christian faith:
